The Checklist

Now that you have budgeted, here is what you need to complete before the design of your website can begin:

____ Decide upon a domain name and an alternate in case your first choice is already in use

Contact a provider and set up an account _____ Tell the provider you want an FTP account

____ Authorize TBR Web Designs as your web designer

Ask your provider to register your domain name (if you have not done that already)

____ Gather together all information and pictures you would like to see included on your web site

____ Create a list of approximately 25 words or phrases that best describe your web site. These will be used to help people "search" for and find your web site once it is registered with search engines.

_ Contact your webmaster.

For example, you may require maintenance once a week, once a month or every few months. Each time you contact TRB Web Designs to make changes to your web site, you will be billed \$100.00 for up to and including 5 changes.

What is considered a change? Examples of changes include, but are not limited to:

- o The addition of a new newsletter
- \circ The deletion of a staff member
- The addition of a new staff member including a biography of the new person

Each of the above examples would be considered one change. Each change in addition to the first 5 will be billed at an additional \$15.00 per change.

If you want to change the look of an entire page, you will be billed at \$125.00 per page since that is considered a redesign.

Billing:

An initial deposit of \$100.00 is required before any work on your web site will begin. When the web site is finished or when maintenance work is completed, an invoice will be emailed to you. Please make all checks out to:

Your Budget

This section describes in detail the 3 costs that you must include in your budget in order to get a web page up and running. These costs consist of:

- A Domain Name
- A Provider
- The Webmaster

A Domain Name

If you want to have unique web address (URL) for your web site, you must register a domain name. Your provider can do this for you or you can do it on your own using a site such as http://www.register.com

If you choose to have your own domain name, your web site address will look like: www.yourcompanyname.com

If you do not have your own domain name, your web site address will look like:

www.yourprovidername.com/yourcompanyname/index.htm.

Having your own domain name costs approximately \$25.00 per year.

The Provider

The provider houses and maintains your web pages on special computers called servers. These servers are connected to other servers throughout the world enabling your web site to be seen by anyone with an Internet connection.

A suggested provider is:

When setting up an account with a provider, tell the provider you want an **FTP** account. Give the provider your domain name or arrange for the provider to register a domain name for you.

Also, authorize TBR Web Designs (Tara Rothman) as your web designer and tell the provider to give TBR Web Designs your username and password. After you give them the authorization, they can email TBR Web Designs the information at tararo@cox.net.

The Webmaster

Pricing as of 01/01/2009

Initial Setup:

The following costs are based on the assumption that you provide all text in electronic format (on disc or via email) and all photos, pictures, and logos. Given these assumptions, the costs for designing a web site are:

- \$120. 00 initial setup (one time fee)
- \$200 for the first 3 pages
- \circ \$100.00 for each additional page
- \circ \$50.00 for each java script or flash text.
- \$50.00 for each form or guest book activated from a pre-written script
- \circ \$50 for customized graphics

Note: A web page is *not* equivalent to one typed page, but rather equates to a section of information about your company.

Maintenance:

Once the site is complete, you might need enhancements or changes to the text or design. This is considered maintenance. Maintenance charges are \$100.00 per request for up to 5 changes. Some companies charge a fee per month whether or not any changes are requested. This is not so with TBR Web Designs. You are billed only when you request a change.
